Release Notes for May, 2023

Implementation Summary

Nelnet Payment Services (NPS) is deploying the projects listed in these release notes to UAT on May 19, 2023 and to PROD on May 24, 2023:

- TSYS TransIT Recertification
- Global Payments Integration and Certification

Multi-Iteration/Coded but Not Yet Deployed

Any project(s) listed here will not be live at the time of the deployment dates indicated above; but are part of a project that will be used in a later release:

- Rapid Connect Recertification
- Apple Pay Integration and Certification

Client Action and Recommended Testing

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
TSYS TransIT Recertification

NPS Direct has completed a recertification with TSYS. PS Direct utilizes the TransIT API 3.0 to integrate with TSYS for authorization and capture processing for credit card transactions in the U.S. Clients are required to have a TSYS merchant account that has access to the TransIT API 3.0 platform.

Global Payments Integration and Certification

NPS Direct has completed an integration and certification to the Global Payments Greenhouse South Authorization Platform (GSAP), utilizing the GSAP ISO 8583 message format. The new integration will allow PS Direct clients to utilize authorization and capture processing on the Global GSAP platform. Clients are required to have a Global Payments merchant account that is configured for and has access to the Global GSAP platform.

Following is an example of the Credit Card Gateway Settings section which shows Global as the Gateway; along with descriptions of other fields:



Gateway - Always set to Global

User ID – The user name assigned to the merchant by Global Payments

Password – A user-defined value (e.g., such as global1234 or some variation). This field isn't an actual password that is validated and nor is it used to process transactions; but a placeholder or a value is required in order to proceed.

Bank ID – The bank ID assigned to the merchant bank by Global Payments (also referred to as the Acquirer Institution ID)

Merchant ID – A unique ID used to identify the merchant. This value is assigned to the merchant by Global Payments (also referred to as the Card Acceptor ID).
