Implementation Summary

Nelnet Payment Services (NPS) deployed the projects listed below to PROD on August 30, 2023. Additional information about the following enhancement is provided on the next page:

The following projects are related to internal NPS maintenance:

- Admin and Merchant Portal Security Updates
- IDP Payment Batch Enhancements

Multi-Iteration

The following projects have additional development and testing requirements and will not be live at the time of the deployment date indicated above. Instead, they are part of a multi-phase project which will be implemented at a later date:

- Apple Pay Integration and Certification
- NPS Risk Service API Updates
- Gateway ACH Bridge Enhancements

Client Action and Recommended Testing

Client action is not required for these enhancements. However, activation of the Risk Service requires coordination with Nelnet Payment Services. Review this information to determine potential impacts to your business processes, policies, and systems to support these enhancements. Clients that choose to utilize these features are strongly encouraged to complete testing prior to implementing in their production environment.

The NPS User Acceptance Test (UAT) environment is available for clients to test new functionality and for regression testing. NPS strongly recommends that you perform regression testing to ensure that your system continues to perform as expected.



New Payment Facilitator MCC Field

NPS has added the Payfac MCC field, which is specific to TransIT only, to the Credit Card Gateway Settings section. This field should only be configured for merchants who are registered as payment facilitators. The MCC (Merchant Category Code) is a four-digit number assigned to describe a merchant's primary business product or service. Following is an example of the updated screen.

Note: Currently, additional development is in progress; therefore, full functionality is not yet available.
