Clients that choose to utilize these features are strongly encouraged to complete testing prior to implementing in their production environment.


The PaymentSpring Direct User Acceptance Test (UAT) environment is available for clients to test new functionality and for regression testing.

## Authorize.net Recertification

PaymentSpring Direct has completed a recertification with Authorize.Net for the Authorize.Net platform. This integration will allow PS Direct clients to utilize authorization and capture processing on the Authorize.Net platform. Clients are required to have a merchant account that is configured for Authorize.Net.

Following is an example of the Credit Card Gateway Settings section which shows Authorize as the Gateway; along with descriptions of other fields:



**Credit Card Gateway Settings**

Gateway

Name

Transaction Key

**Name** – The user name assigned to the merchant by Authorize.Net.

**Transaction Key** – A complex value generated by Authorize.Net that uniquely identifies a merchant's payment gateway account. It is similar to an account password, but can only be used to authenticate requests submitted to Authorize.Net.
